SUBJECT: 2014 YOUTH WORLD CUP DEADLINES

The 2014 American Quarter Horse Youth World Cup is a little over a year away and plans are beginning to take shape! We look forward to seeing your country's team in Bryan, Texas.

Lots of preparation goes into securing the location, hotel, transportation, meals, horses and other necessities for the Youth World Cup. To better serve the participating countries, AQHA needs commitment as soon as possible. *PLEASE INFORM AQHA OF YOUR COUNTRY'S INTENT TO PARTICIPATE BY* **MAY 15, 2013**.

Payment for your country's team, verifying your intention to compete, should be submitted by **July 1, 2013**. PLEASE NOTE, THE FIRST PAYMENT OF \$3,000* IS DUE BY **JULY 1, 2013** OR RISK BEING DENIED THE OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE OR HAVE LIMITED PARTICIPATION.

Additionally, ALL 2014 QUALIFYING PROCEDURES MUST BE ON FILE WITH AQHA BY **JULY 1, 2013**. Even if you have submitted your qualifying procedures for previous Youth World Cups, we must have a new, updated copy on file. After July 1, the Youth World Cup Committee will verify deposits and review qualification procedures to make recommendations for eligible teams.

All items must be returned to David Avery.

Another deadline you should be aware of:

DEADLINE – MARCH 31, 2014

- LIST OF POTENTIAL TEAM MEMBERS MUST BE ON FILE WITH AQHA
- \$2,000 second team payment due
- Any non-competing individuals participating must submit a deposit of \$500**
- Team members, both competing and non-competing, MUST BE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING OF AQHYA BY THIS DATE.
